## STEELS CREEK TENNIS & PLAY GROUP

Libby Sharp and Morgan Calder set up a mothers tennis group at the Steel Creek Tennis Club, where mums bring their kids to the courts and have an hour coaching session or social game while the kids play. At the last session, there were ten players to form rotating teams with some on the sideline to watch the kids and natter while the other mums played. They had provisions for a social game to take place at the same time as the coaching to allow for more people to join the action.

This was set up with help from the Woman's Health 'Woman's Gathering After the Fires' grant to get women and the kids in Steels Creek together after the bushfire. It was available when people were starting to want to 'do' things together and get some exercise. "It has grown into something that has produced much laughter and a positive distraction from the monotonous activities of rebuilding and establishing a new kind of life after the fires." Said Morgan. "We run our group on a Thursday during school term dates, and at the end of term 2 we had a mini tournament with four awards, followed by a BBQ." Having taken a break over term 3 due to the cold winter, They're hankering to get back on the court and get together.



## SCTC RECOGNIZED BY STATE AWARD

Your SC Tennis Club was recognized at the 2009 Victorian Sport and Recreation Awards ceremony on 23 November 2009 at the MCG for its "outstanding contribution to bushfire recovery". The press release said "Sports clubs such as Steels Creek Tennis Club are at the heart of many communities and provide a place for families and friends to get together and in times of adversity, sport can play a key role in building community strength. Our bushfire-affected clubs are playing a key role as communities rebuild, recover in the months and years after the fires." ## FUTURE PROJECTS

### • Parking Project

Our project to develop safer, off-street parking has been shelved as the proposed land was not available for purchase. However, the Shire is still working with us on options. We thank all those who came to a recent public meeting about one ill-fated proposal, especially for your support of other options for your Club. We'll see what can be done near the courts in the future.

### • Club Building

Thanks to a grant from the Sugarloaf Pipeline Alliance and the Shire of Yarra Ranges, a new building is replacing the familiar 'bus shelter' room and outdoor toilet block. The foundation was laid in late October, and a building should be rising soon. The new basic kitchen facilities and indoor toilets will be a welcome improvement.
