The Shire of Yarra Ranges provided SCTC with a grant of \$15,000 toward the upgrade, with proceeds from the dinners and raffles paying the rest. The new surface was put down over the existing base, saving quite a bit in the construction.

- **Parking Project**

Our project to develop safer, off-street parking was progressing until last month when the Shire ran into a snag in purchasing the land. We still hope we can proceed. Currently, the plans called for parking along the north and west sides of the reserve. Keep watching for future developments.

- **Box Lights**

Your Committee submitted a funding request to the Shire's Capital Grants program to upgrade our lighting to box lights. The current lights fan out horizontally and waste a lot of light on the street and off the courts. Box lights will direct the lights downward and provide better lighting to the courts and less distracting light to the street and neighbors.
