## **Understanding Bushfire Warnings & Advice**

There are three different levels of warnings:

- Advice: An incident is occurring or has occurred in the area. Access information and monitor conditions.
- Watch and Act: An emergency is heading towards you. Conditions are changing and you need to start taking action now to protect yourself and your family.
- Emergency Warning: You are in imminent danger and need to take action now. You will be impacted.

The warning level is based on incident conditions and impact on the community; therefore, the first warning issued could be an Emergency Warning - the highest level of warning.
