Matters arising from previous minutes:

- Busy Bee Two busy bees have been held since the last meeting and both have been very productive. Scheduling the BB at 9am before the Exchange Hub is working well. This arrangement will continue as we slowly work to maintain the community centre surrounds.
- Evacuation Plan Ivan submitted the plans to council and was informed
 there were specific requirements for leased council property evacuation plans.
 Subsequently, a link has been provided to Ivan with those requirements. It is
 possible that an "Emergency Meeting Point" sign will be required to be
 erected in our lower carpark. Should this be necessary, an approach to
 council for installation will be made. ACTION: Ivan to explore the link,
 prepare the plan and post at the evacuation points within the community
 centre.

 and presented to committee (see copy below). Additional suggestion is to add
 the Ritchies Card information to the letter, ensuring it does not extend the
 letter to more than one page. ACTION: Maree and Fiona continue to work on

 ACTION: Delia to bring a plan of how the Garden Club will set out their stalls on the day; Kerry to put a "Save the Date" notice in the grapevine; Maree to approach Stitchers to see if they would make "showbags" for the day where we can put in our Donation letter, Welcome to steels Creek flyer and Fire Guard map
- Jolly Thing All information has been received from Morgan Calder. The
 logo is being used for the welcome pack. Discussed trying to get the JT
 published again but instead as an annual edition, reviewing the year past.
 ACTION: Kerry to include a request in the Grapevine for anyone who would
 be interested in doing an annual publication rather than a quarterly one.
- **Window cleaning** will be carried out on October 12th at 9am before Exchange Hub. **ACTION**: Kerry to put notice of window cleaning and gardening busy bee in Grapevine.
- Community Resilience Update Derek Schlennstedt response regarding
 the Energy update enquiry was as follows:
 "I wanted to update you about the latest development at the Steels Creek
 Community Centre. An energy audit was recently completed, and the
 - o Installation of a 4.4kW solar system

following upgrades have been identified:

- Installation of a generator plug-in point
- Installation of a cabinet for batteries, though (batteries will not be included)

We anticipate that the installations may be completed by November 2024 (sic)"

ACTION: Kerry to contact Derek to inform of the Garden Show/Open day and ensure works do not interfere with that event; Kerry and Erin-Maree O'Neill will dust off the welcome pack and send to committee for any suggestions of additional information; Maree to contact Brett Ellis re resilience training; Kerry to find out where the YGL&LC get their quarterly program printed; Kerry to research the signs and in put a grant to the council for the sign.

Door Lock – If we are to update the key lock as per council requirements
then a new door will be necessary in order to attach an appropriate lock. As
per our lease, the door falls under council responsibility. ACTION:
lvan/Maree to contact the council and discuss the issue of requiring a new
door with an appropriate lock at council expense.
